All horses must have up to date vaccinations.

There will no refunds after close of entry for any reason.

Any refunds made before will have 5% deducted. If cancelled because of Covid all entries will be carried forward.

Follow all signage and instructions at the centre

Only one person can accompany a rider.

There will be no prizes awarded after the class Rosettes will be given to the collecting ring steward straight after the class and you can collect them from her.

There will be no access to seating or viewing facilities.

Only 1 person can accompany 1 rider. There will be no refund of entries after close of entry.

please as you will need to leave site once you have jumped .

Rules of the competition are as follows.

Riders cannot compete in more than two classes per day. Horses/ponies cannot compete more than once in each class or in more than two classes on the day.

Stop Watches are not permitted. The winner will be the competitor with the lowest number of penalties. In the event of a tie the winner will be the one closest to the optimum time. There should be a drawn order and, where possible, approximate start times given in advance of the day The course will only be open for walking before the class starts. The Judge's decision is final.

PENALTIES SJ Phase: Knocking down obstacle 4 penalties

First disobedience of horse 4 penalties

Second disobedience of horse in whole course 8 penalties

Third disobedience of horse in whole course Elimination* (Each circle or crossing tracks between fences counts as one disobedience)

First fall of rider Elimination

* Fall of Horse Elimination

*Error of course not rectified Elimination

*Failure to start or jump next fence within 60 seconds Elimination

* Starting before the Bell Elimination

* Continuing the course without a hat, or with chinstrap undone Elimination

* *Competitors eliminated in this phase may not proceed to the XC phase

XC Phase Knocking down an obstacle 4 penalties

First refusal, run-out or circle of horse at obstacle 20 penalties

Second refusal, run-out or circle at same obstacle 40 penalties

Third refusal, run-out or circle at same obstacle Elimination

Four refusals around the course Elimination

Fall of horse Elimination Fall of rider

Elimination Error of Course not rectified

Elimination Horse trapped in obstacle

Elimination Horse resisting rider for 60 consecutive seconds anywhere on the course

Elimination Failure to cross the finish line mounted Elimination Continuing the course without a hat, or with chinstrap undone Elimination

Time will be taken overall. For every commenced second in excess of the optimum time 0.4 penalty
Every commenced second in excess of 5 seconds under the optimum time 0.4 penalty

Exceeding the time limit Elimination

Time limit is twice the optimum time.

RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY`

1. *Current British Standard Headgear must be worn at all times when mounted. Body Protectors are compulsory. Skull caps or hats with a 3 point harness correctly fastened are mandatory for any show jumping competition. No peaked hats. All hats Must be up to the current standard.*

2. *The judges decision is final .*

3. *To enter this show you need not be a member, but qualification will only be given to those who fulfil the relevant criteria as per the society rules for the regional finals where appropriate.*

4. *Entry fees are not refundable even with a vets certificate.*

5. There are no dogs allowed on the show ground except for guide dogs.

6. *It is strongly recommended that all exhibitors carry adequate Public Liability Insurance. Sunnybank EC its employees or assistants do not accept any liability for any injury or damage sustained by any third party whether to horse/rider spectator or property whatsoever and how so ever caused.*

7. *The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without any reason being given and if necessary to alter or cancel any class at anytime.*

8. *Any vehicles parked do so at their own risk.*

9. *All horses/ponies must be 4 years old or over to compete in ridden classes. Pony Club rules state that in the PC Qualifiers ponies or horses must be 5 years or more .*

10. *Whips are not allowed to exceed 30" (75cms). Jump bats only are permitted.*

11. *Any objections must be received in writing within 10 minutes of the conclusion of the class together with a deposit of £30 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.*

12. *No lungeing working in or cantering is allowed in the lorry park no dung to be left in carpark. Anyone found skipping out lorries/trailers jn the carpark putting manure in the bins or leaving it on the show ground will be banned.*

13. Sunnybank EC has animals and children present. We must insist on a strict 5mph speed limit.

14. *All children attending Sunnybank EC must be supervised by a responsible adult.*

SBEC Rules apply to this qualifier

15. Anyone found skipping out their lorries/trailers in the car park, or dumping manure in the bins will be fined and banned. Take your manure home.

16. strictly no Dogs allowed on the show ground except guide dogs.

you can compete in a maximum of 2 classes per horse/pony.

17. Anyone found bringing a horse or pony to Sunnybank which has knowingly been in contact with any infectious or contagious diseases or have known diseases will be asked to leave and banned for life.

18. All horses/ponies attending our events must be fully vaccinated . Spot checks will be made.



How to avoid catching or spreading coronavirus

Do

- ✓ wash your hands with soap and water often – do this for at least 20 seconds
- ✓ always wash your hands when you get home or into work
- ✓ use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available
- ✓ cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze
- ✓ put used tissues in the bin straight away and wash your hands afterwards

Don't

- ✗ do not touch your eyes, nose or mouth if your hands are not clean

Covid-19 Measures

In order for us to run we must follow all the rules which have been implemented.

Before Travelling

- If you, or any of your party are feeling ill, DO NOT TRAVEL.
- If you answer yes to any of the following questions, do not travel to the showground.
- Do you have a new continuous cough?
- Have you experienced a loss of, or change in sense of smell or taste (anosmia).
 - Are you in the High risk, clinically extremely vulnerable category?
 - Are you self isolating, due to contact with someone with symptoms, someone with confirmed covid 19, or returning from a country known to have the virus?
- Do not travel with anyone outside your household unless you can maintain safe social distancing (2 meters).

- Competitors may be accompanied by one other person and one additional person for every additional horse entered. A person under 18 can only have 1 adult with them and no siblings unless entered.

At the Show

- You must park 5 metres apart.
 - Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied on the showground by an adult and children under the age of 14 must be supervised at all times.
 - Only one groom / helper per horse is permitted in the collecting ring at any one time.
 - Please note the 5mph speed limit on the showground must be observed at all times.
 - All horses / ponies entering the showground must have a valid equine passport and must be properly vaccinated according to the relevant Governing Body.
 - All riders, drivers, grooms and helpers must have their own third party liability insurance.
 - By entering the showground, you agree to abide by these Rules and Regulations, as well as any other rulebook specific to the event..

Warm Up

Current Rules are that no more than 6 people are permitted in the arena. This is a combined number limit of riders plus any grooms etc.

- You must listen to the collecting ring steward . Failure to do so will result in you being asked to leave and forfeiting any entries made.
- Social distancing must be maintained at all times. If anyone is seen to be stood closer than 2m, the collecting ring steward will take action.
- Maximum time allowed to warm up will be 15 minutes.

Arena

- There will be a one-way system in operation for horses and pedestrians. This must be adhered to at all times. Failure to do so will result in you being asked to leave and forfeiting any entries made.
- Only the person accompanying you will be allowed to watch the round in the indoor arena.
- You must follow all signage and instructions.
- There are hand sanitiser points throughout the Arena and hand washing facilities. Please use them.

Competitions

- You will be allocated times to compete.
- The order will not be changed. If you miss your time we will not be able to let you jump.
- The drawn order list will be on the website and on the Large doors of the Arena.
- There will not be any awarding of prizes at the event.
- Results will be out on the website after the days competition or on Horse Monkey if BD.
- You must leave the Show ground immediately on completion of your classes.
- If entered in more than one class you must go back to your lorry or trailer and wait there until it is your turn to warm up and compete.
- There can only be 6 people at any one time whether in the warm up or waiting to compete.

Catering

- The burger van will be onsite. You will need to remain 2 metres apart whilst waiting to be served. There is a one way system in operation.
- You will need to eat your food outdoors or at your lorry or trailer.
- Toilets are in use but you must keep 2 metres apart. They will be cleaned regularly. .

If the above rules are not adhered to we will not be able to run our competitions. Anyone found breaking the rules or not listening to the stewards will be asked to leave and all entries or prize money forfeited , Anyone showing any form of abuse to Stewards, volunteers or Sunnybanks staff will be asked to leave the show ground and all entries made forfeited.

Sunnybank EC it's employees officials stewards or anyone volunteering shall in any way be liable for any accident, injury, damage or loss or for anything that may happen (from any cause or circumstances whatsoever) to Exhibitors, Competitors, or members of the General Public or their Servants, Agents or to anyone on the Showground, or for any loss, claim, matter circumstance or event whatsoever in connection with or arising out of nor attributable or any journey to or from the Show.

- No individual for which he/she is responsible as owner lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure that other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.

- The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry; cancel or alter classes or postpone the event due to unforeseen circumstances. The organisers also reserve the right, if necessary, to amend the schedule, which may mean that riders compete in less classes than advertised. In the unlikely event that the event is cancelled, the Organisers will return everyone's monies, less an administration charge of up to 50% of the total price, to cover the irrecoverable costs of preparing to host the event.
