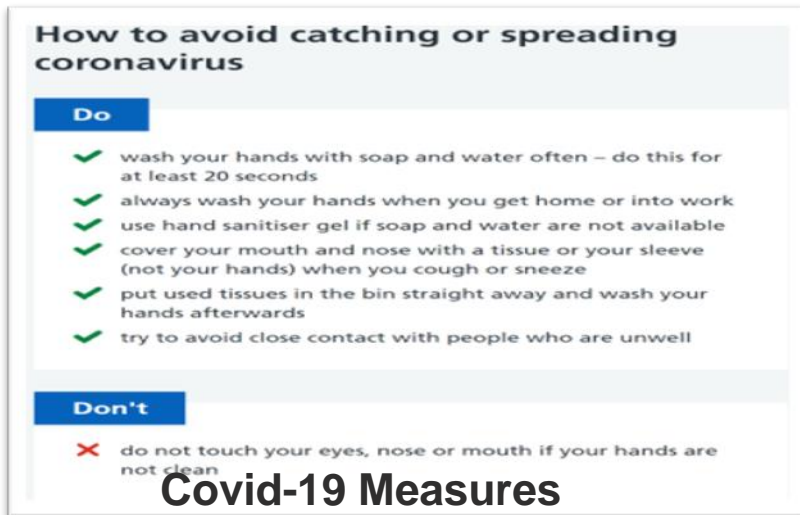
Entries must be received no later than the Tuesday PRIOR to the competition. Times available Thursday .Strictly no telephone entries and no entries by hand at THE HOUSE. Entries maybe given by hand whilst the centre is open for competitions.on line or by post with card details. Late entries will not be accepted unless space allows and providing times have not been released.

**Novice & Elementary classes will only run if there are 4 or more entries
In order to be eligible to enter Intro Classes, Horse and rider combination must not be not have been placed 1st 2nd or 3rd in a Prelim test or above. To be eligible for Prelim. Horse must not have more than 20 BD Novice points.**

RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Correct British Standard Headgear must be worn at all times when mounted. It is strongly recommended that all riders wear back protectors whilst jumping. Skull caps or hats with a 3 point harness correctly fastened are mandatory for any show jumping competition.
2. The judges decision is final .
3. To enter this show you need not be a member, but qualification will only be given to those who fulfil the relevant criteria as per the society rules for the regional finals where appropriate.
4. Entry fees are not refundable even with a vets certificate.
5. **There are no dogs allowed on the show ground except for guide dogs.**
6. It is strongly recommended that all exhibitors carry adequate Public Liability Insurance. Sunnybank EC its employees or assistants do not accept any liability for any injury or damage sustained by any third party whether to horse/rider spectator or property whatsoever and how so ever caused.
7. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without any reason being given and if necessary to alter or cancel any class at anytime.
8. Any vehicles parked do so at their own risk.
9. All horses/ponies must be 4 years old or over to compete in ridden classes.

11. Any objections must be received in writing within 10 minutes of the conclusion of the class together with a deposit of £30 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
12. No lungeing working in or cantering is allowed in the lorry park.
13. No dung or bedding is to be left in the car park.
14. All children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
15. At Sunnybank Ec we have animals and children . Therefore the maximum speed limit is 5mph.
16. No refund of entries will be given. In the event of the competition being cancelled prior to the day, entries may be carried forward to another competition. In the event of the competition being cancelled once it has started, no refunds will be given
17. **Anyone found bringing a horse or pony to Sunnybank which has knowingly been in contact with any infectious or contagious diseases or have known diseases will be asked to leave and banned for life**
18. **All horses/ponies attending our events must be fully vaccinated . Spot checks will be made on passports.**

Covid-19 Measures

In order for us to run we must follow all the rules which have been implemented.

We are all in this together.

To keep the shows running, we must all work together to ensure that the rules are maintained to give us all a positive experience and go home safely. Follow the signage and adhere to the rules. We thank you in advance for your full cooperation in complying with our rules and implementing requests from our staff, security staff and officials on site to ensure everyone's safety and enjoyment of the show. We look forward to more events and seeing you in the future.

REMEMBER TO BEAT COVID FOLLOW THE RULES:-

Before Travelling

- If you, or any of your party are feeling ill, DO NOT TRAVEL. Follow the guidance: Full Guidance
- Your temperature may be checked on arrival to allow access to the showground. Those who are found to have a high temperature will not be allowed access to the show. Please check your own temperature before departing to avoid making a pointless journey. If your temperature is over 37.8c DO NOT TRAVEL.
- If you answer yes to any of the following questions, do not travel to the showground.
 - Do you have a new continuous cough?
 - Have you experienced a loss of, or change in sense of smell or taste (anosmia).
 - Are you self isolating, due to contact with someone with symptoms, someone with confirmed Covid-19, or returning from a country known to have the virus?
 - Have you been asked to self-isolate by Track, Trace, Protect (TTP) or you are a contact for someone who has had a positive result?

- Only travel to the showground if you are able to return home at any time during the show due to the onset of symptoms for you or anyone within your group.
- **The number of people attending will be limited to 6 people for each rider. These people should all be from the same household bubble.**
- Explain social distancing to anyone in your support group and limit access to stables and arenas to essential personnel only and provide the appropriate face coverings for everyone within your group.
- Do not travel with anyone outside your household unless you can maintain safe social distancing (2 meters) at all times and whilst travelling.
- You will be asked to supply your contact details, name address mobile and home telephone details and that of your party to enable contact tracing in the event of a positive case at the venue.

At the Show

- You must park 5 metres apart.
 - Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied on the showground by an adult and children under the age of 14 must be supervised at all times..
 - Please note the 5mph speed limit on the showground must be observed at all times.
 - All horses / ponies entering the showground must have a valid equine passport and must be properly vaccinated according to the relevant Governing Body.
 - All riders, drivers, grooms and helpers must have their own third party liability insurance.
 - By entering the showground, you agree to abide by these Rules and Regulations, as well as any other rulebook specific to the event..

Warm Up

Current Rules are that no more than 6 people are permitted in the arena. This is a combined number limit of riders plus any grooms etc.

- You must listen to the collecting ring steward . Failure to do so will result in you being asked to leave and forfeiting any entries made.
- Social distancing must be maintained at all times. If anyone is seen to be stood closer than 2m, the collecting ring steward will take action.
- Maximum time allowed to warm up will be 30 minutes.

Arena

- There will be a one-way system in operation for horses and pedestrians. This must be adhered to at all times. Failure to do so will result in you being asked to leave and forfeiting any entries made.
- You must follow all signage and instructions.
- There are hand sanitiser points throughout the Arena and hand washing facilities. Please use them.

Competitions

- You will be allocated times to compete.
- The order will not be changed. If you miss your time we will not be able to let you jump.
- The drawn order list will be on the website and on the Large doors of the Arena.
- Prizes will be given to you by the collecting ring steward.
- Results will be out on the website 2 days after the days competition or on Horse Monkey if BD.

- There can only be 6 people at any one time whether in the warm up or waiting to compete.

Catering

- The burger van will be onsite. You will need to remain 2 metres apart whilst waiting to be served. There is a one way system in operation.
- You will need to eat your food outdoors or at your lorry or trailer.
- Toilets are in use but you must keep 2 metres apart. They will be cleaned regularly. .

If the above rules are not adhered to we will not be able to run our competitions. Anyone found breaking the rules or not listening to the stewards will be asked to leave and all entries or prize money forfeited , Anyone showing any form of abuse to Stewards, volunteers or Sunnybanks staff will be asked to leave the show ground and all entries made forfeited.

Sunnybank EC it's employees officials stewards or anyone volunteering shall in any way be liable for any accident, injury, damage or loss or for anything that may happen (from any cause or circumstances whatsoever) to Exhibitors, Competitors, or members of the General Public or their Servants, Agents or to anyone on the Showground, or for any loss, claim, matter circumstance or event whatsoever in connection with or arising out of nor attributable or any journey to or from the Show.

- No individual for which he/she is responsible as owner lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure that other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.

- The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry; cancel or alter classes or postpone the event due to unforeseen circumstances. The organisers also reserve the right, if necessary, to amend the schedule, which may mean that riders compete in less classes than advertised. In the unlikely event that the event is cancelled, the Organisers will return everyone's monies, less an administration charge of up to 50% of the total price, to cover the irrecoverable costs of preparing to host the event.
